

CLASS 8 WASHINGTON, D.C. TRIP MEDICATION PERMIT FORM

DUE MARCH 27

Prescription and non-prescription medication may be administered by a designate of the Headmaster on the Class 8 D.C. Field Trip 2024. This completed form, along with the medication, must be brought to the school nurse's office by the parent by 2:30 p.m., Wednesday, March 27. A separate form must be filled out for each medication. Students may not keep any medications on their persons, in their suitcase, or in their hotel rooms.

Note:

- 1. The signed permission form from the parent/legal guardian must accompany each medication.
- 2. Any unused medication will be destroyed one week after the trip if not picked up by the parent.
- 3. Prescription medication must be prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist, dispensed by a registered pharmacist and properly labeled with the doctor's name.
- 4. All medication, whether prescription or over the counter, must be labeled with the student's name, medication, dosing instructions, and in the original container.
- 5. All medication necessary for the student during the trip must be given to the school nurse by March 27, 2024.
